

Monthly Book Report Format

Book Reports must be typed or written in pen. You must write using complete sentences and create 10 sections leaving a space between sections. **You should take notes while you read.**

1. **Introduction**: The introduction includes the Title (which must be underlined), the author, and the type of fiction (i.e. realistic, fantasy, science etc.) 5pts.
2. **Setting**: The setting must include the time and place in which the novel takes place. It must also contain evidence from the novel on how you determined the setting. Evidence can be a quote from the novel with the page number or just details from the book. 10 pts.
3. **Character**: In this section you must tell me the names three characters in the book, who they are/their role in the book, and give 3 traits with evidence for each character. Also, state who the protagonist is and who the antagonist is. Each character must be a separate paragraph. 15pts.
4. **How the main character changes**: In this section you must state how the main character changes or what they learn in the book. You must explain how they were in the beginning, how they changed, and what caused them to change. 10pts
5. **Plot summary**: This section must be 3 paragraphs. Describe what happens in the story: beginning, middle, and end. 15 pts.
6. **Conflict and Resolution**: In this section you must tell me what the conflict is and how it was resolved in the end. Use the words conflict and resolution in your answer. 10 pts.
7. **Theme**: In this section you must tell me the theme of the novel and then give details from the book that explain how you determined that is the theme. Example: honesty is the best policy, don't give up, or we all need help sometimes. Remember themes are general and apply to everyone. This must be a well-developed paragraph. 10 pts.
8. **Apply the theme to your life**: In a well-developed paragraph, re-state the theme and give specific details from your life where you too learned the same thing. 10pts.
9. **Opinion**: State your opinion of the book, 3 reasons why you did or did not like the book with details to support each reason. 10 pts.
10. **Recommendation**: To whom would you recommend the book to and why. 5 pts.
